2. **Locations:** Camp will be held at John Muir Elementary  
3301 S Horton Street Seattle, WA 98144  
Any K-5 student is eligible to register, you don't need to be a  
student at any of the participating Powerful Schools.
3. **Tuition:** Tuition is due at registration, unless special permission  
is given by the program director and a payment plan has been  
arranged.

**Partial Scholarships:** Partial scholarships are awarded based on need  
and a first come, first serve, basis. In order to do so, Powerful Schools  
needs verification of income ( food stamp card, public access medical,  
etc. are acceptable). You must send income verification along with  
your registration. This information will be considered confidential  
and not shared with anyone.

4. **Course Cancellation:** Powerful Schools reserves the right to cancel or  
modify camp classes when necessary. Courses are canceled if the minimum  
enrollment of students is not reached by the deadline for registration. If a  
course is canceled, students and parents will be notified by phone.

**Refund Policy:**

- When classes are canceled by Powerful Schools, complete  
refunds are given.
- Students who withdraw before the second class, will receive  
75% of their tuition costs.
- After the second class, no refunds will be given.

5. **Late Fee Policy:** At the end of the camp, the authorized  
pick-up person will be given a **5 minute grace** period to pick-up their  
child(ren). After 5 minutes, a late fee of **\$1 per minute** will be instituted.  
Late fees are to be paid in full to the staff on duty prior to the subsequent  
class. We request parents to make alternative pick-up plans in case  
of an emergency and notify Powerful Schools staff. Two late pick-ups are  
cause for termination from the program. If any child is still at the school  
after the Program Managers shift has ended, the Seattle Police or Child  
Protective Services will be contacted.
